



As you set off on your new adventure at Springdale Preparatory School, you probably have a lot of questions. Here are a few answers to new students' most commonly-asked questions.

May I mail items I would like for my room prior to moving?

Yes! Direct packages to Springdale Preparatory School. Label your packages with your name - "Residence." Please do not mail items to arrive before July 25, 2024. Your items will be stored at the school and brought to the residence halls. See the example label below.

May I move in a day early?

Please do not arrive to the residence hall prior to your move-in date. We will not accept early arrivals. If you arrive to Maryland before the designated move-in date, please book a hotel in the area.

May I move in a day late?

In order to receive full-service move-in help, we highly recommend you coordinate your travel plans to arrive during your move-in dates. Late arrivals are permitted, but you must communicate with Director of Admissions Daniele Tellish (daniele.tellish@springdaleprep.org) and Head of Residential Life William Douglas (william. douglas@springdaleprep.org), as soon as any changes are made.
